Indira Gandhi Delhi Technical University for Women has successfully conducted One Week Specialized Training Programme on “**Cyber Security and Digital Crime Investigation**” for **Delhi Police Inspectors** and research scholars and UG and PG students of IGDTUW, from 23rd December, 2019 to 28th December, 2019 under the aegis of ISEA Project, MeitY, Govt. of India. The training program was inaugurated by Sh Michi Paku, IPS, Principal, PTS, Delhi Police and Dr Amita Dev, Hon’ble Vice Chancellor, IGDTUW.

The training program was attended by 20 Inspectors from Delhi Police and 25 students of IGDTUW, dealing with day to day cases related with Cyber Crime. During the program, the participants have been provided training on Cyber Crime Investigation through Case Studies, Investigation of Facebook related crimes, ATM frauds, Financial crimes, Social Media crimes, Digital Forensics, Mobile Forensics etc using Forensics Tool Kit, Oxygen Forensics and other open source tools.

The Training Program also emphasized on Bit Coin, Cyber warfare and open trending cases, Deep and Dark Web investigation, Ethical Hacking etc. The lectures were taken by the IGDTUW Faculty alongwith Industry Experts having vast experience in the area of investigating and solving Cyber Crimes.

The valedictory function was attended by Dr. Amita Dev, Hon’ble Vice Chancellor, IGDTUW and Sh. Sunil Garg, Special Commissioner of Police, Training, Delhi Police.
