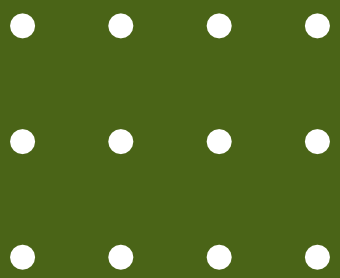

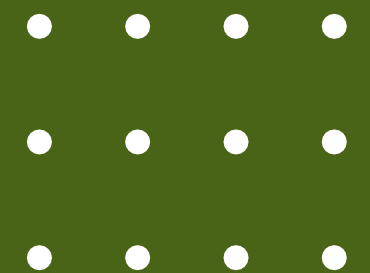

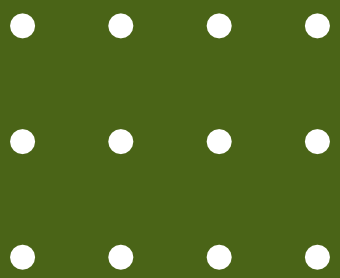

The students are delighted with 252 summer internship offers being extended at the very initial days of the placement season. The University is expecting more prominent offers like these in the coming years.

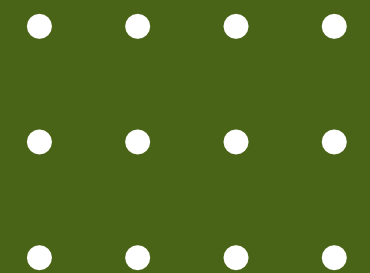

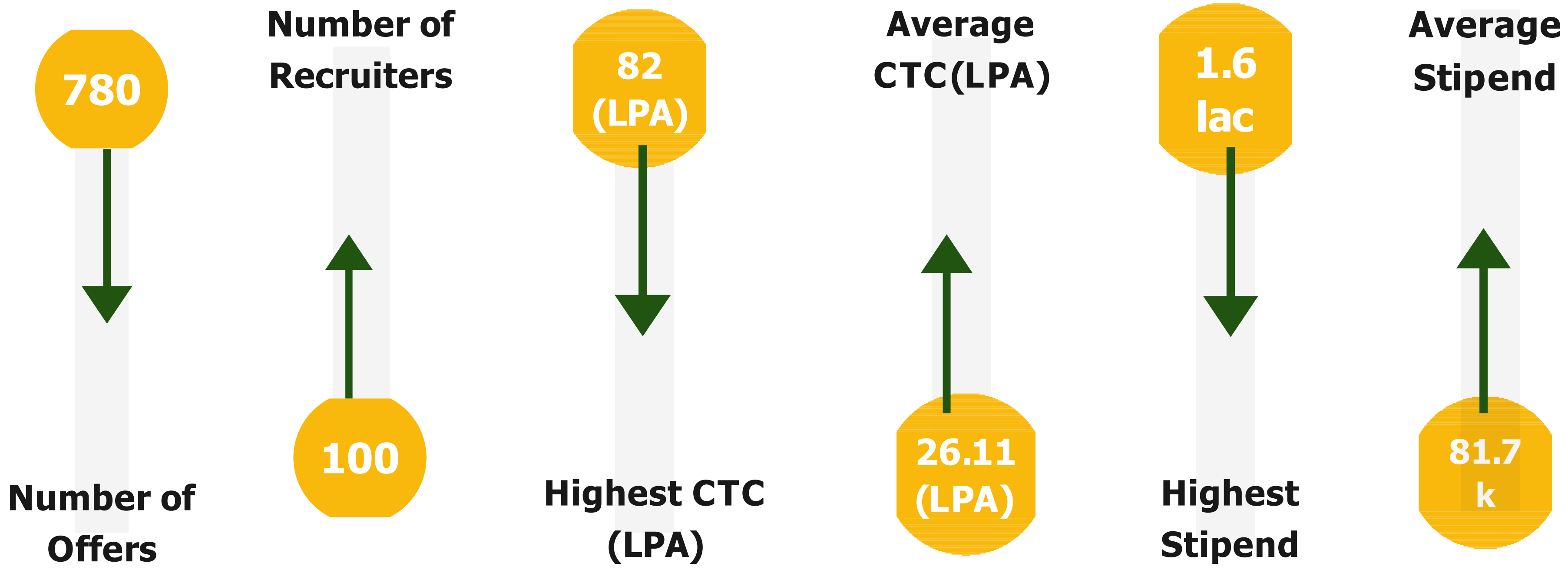

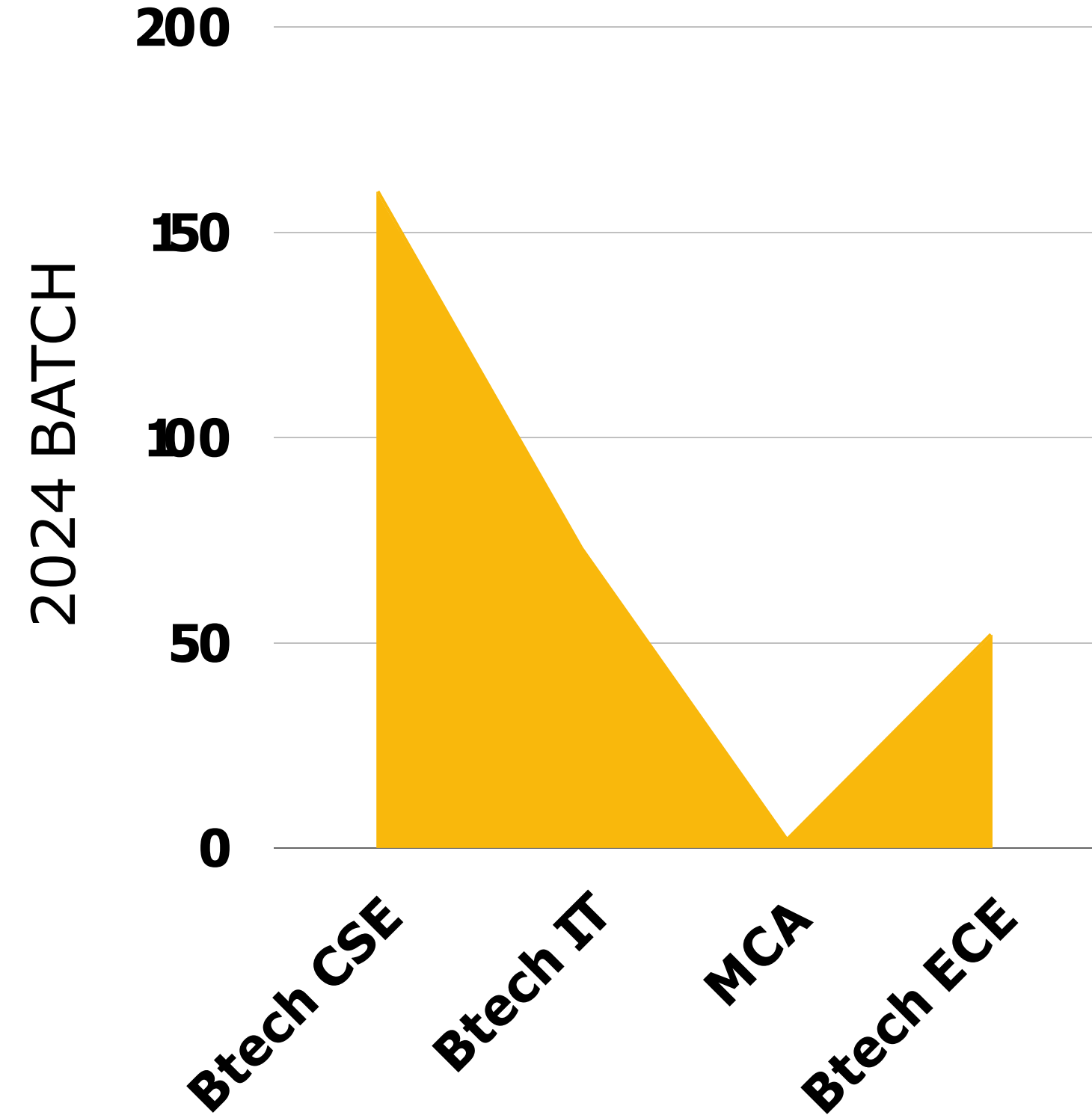

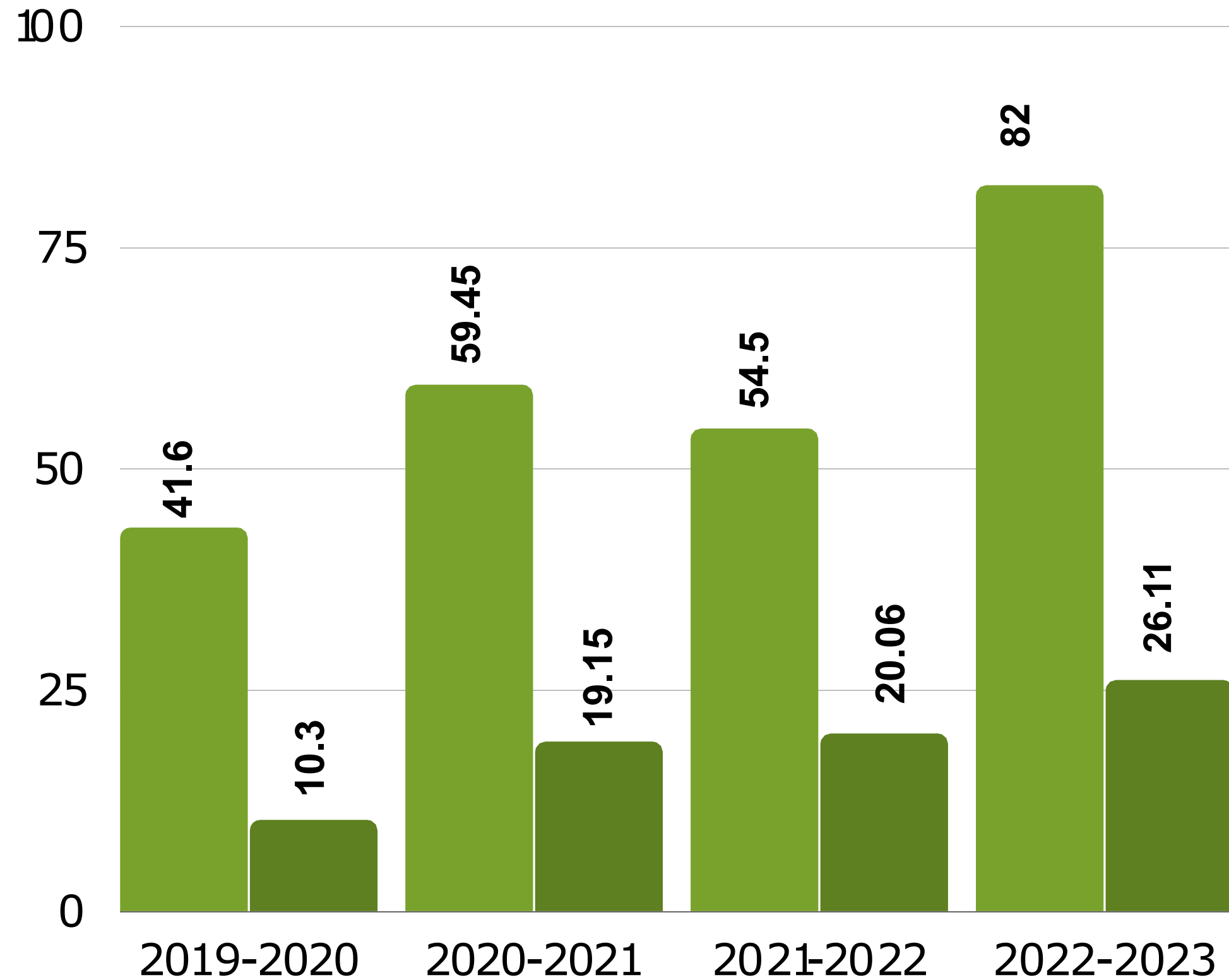
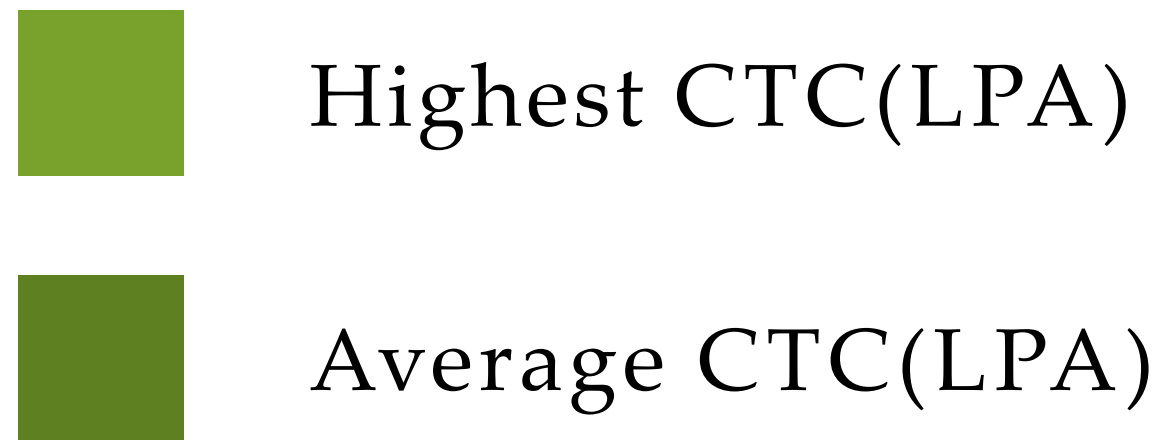




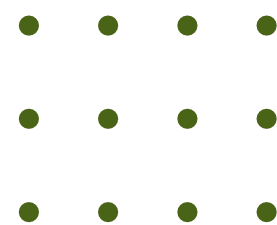
Yearwise Average CTC and Highest CTC comparison (CSE , IT , ECE)

Companies offers RSU' s (Restricted Stocks Unit) and bonuses , the component of which in the ctc varies every year



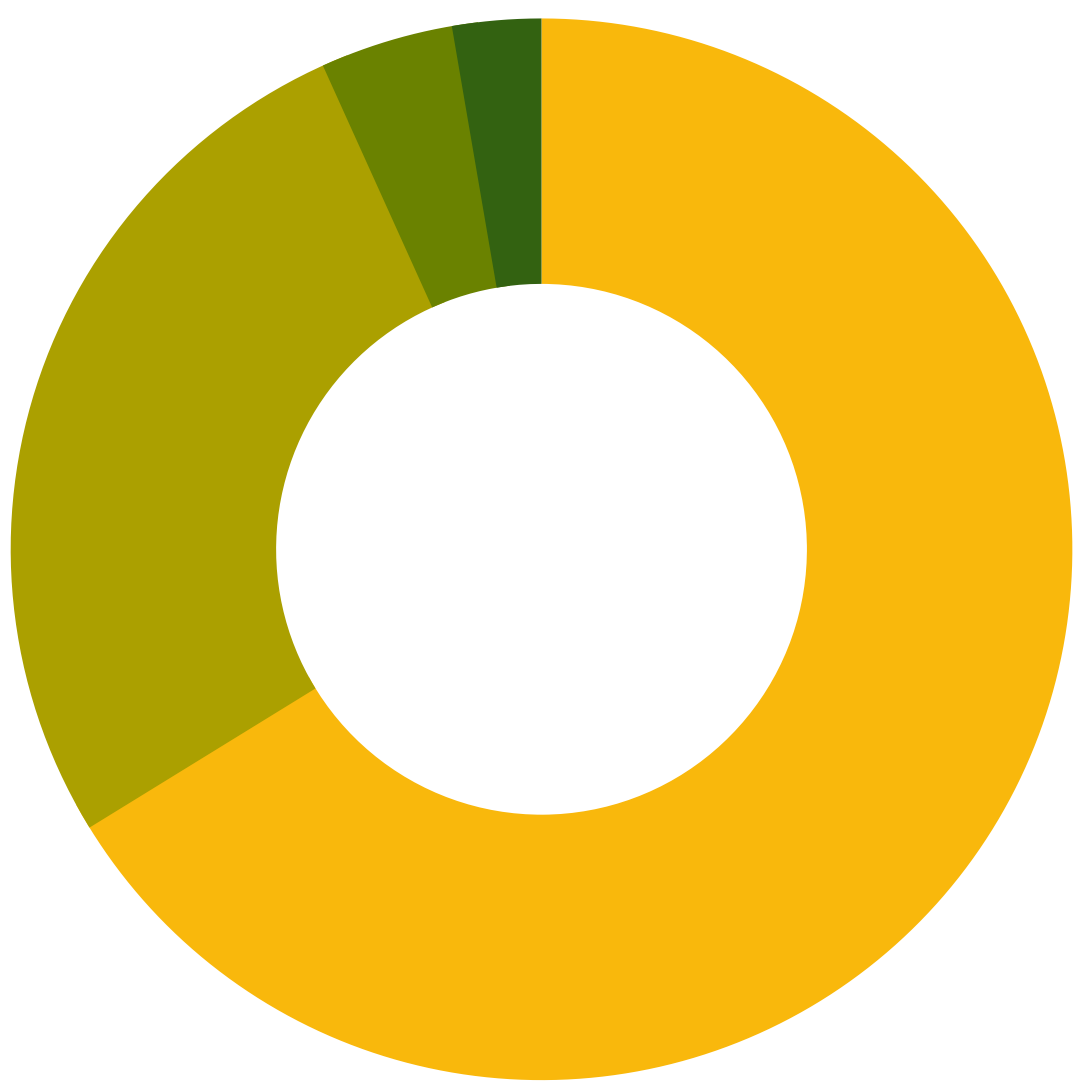


Full-Time Offer Distribution

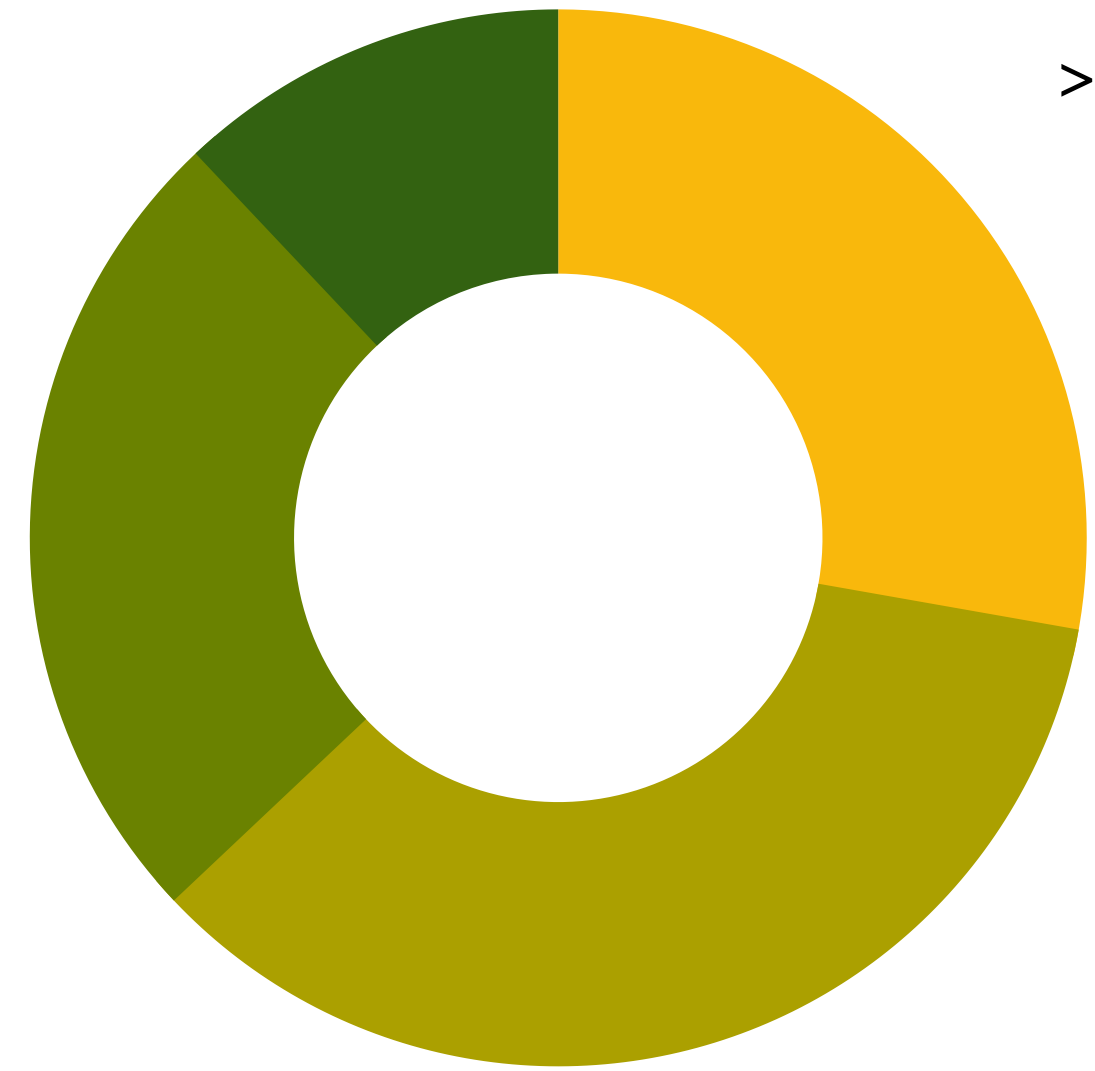

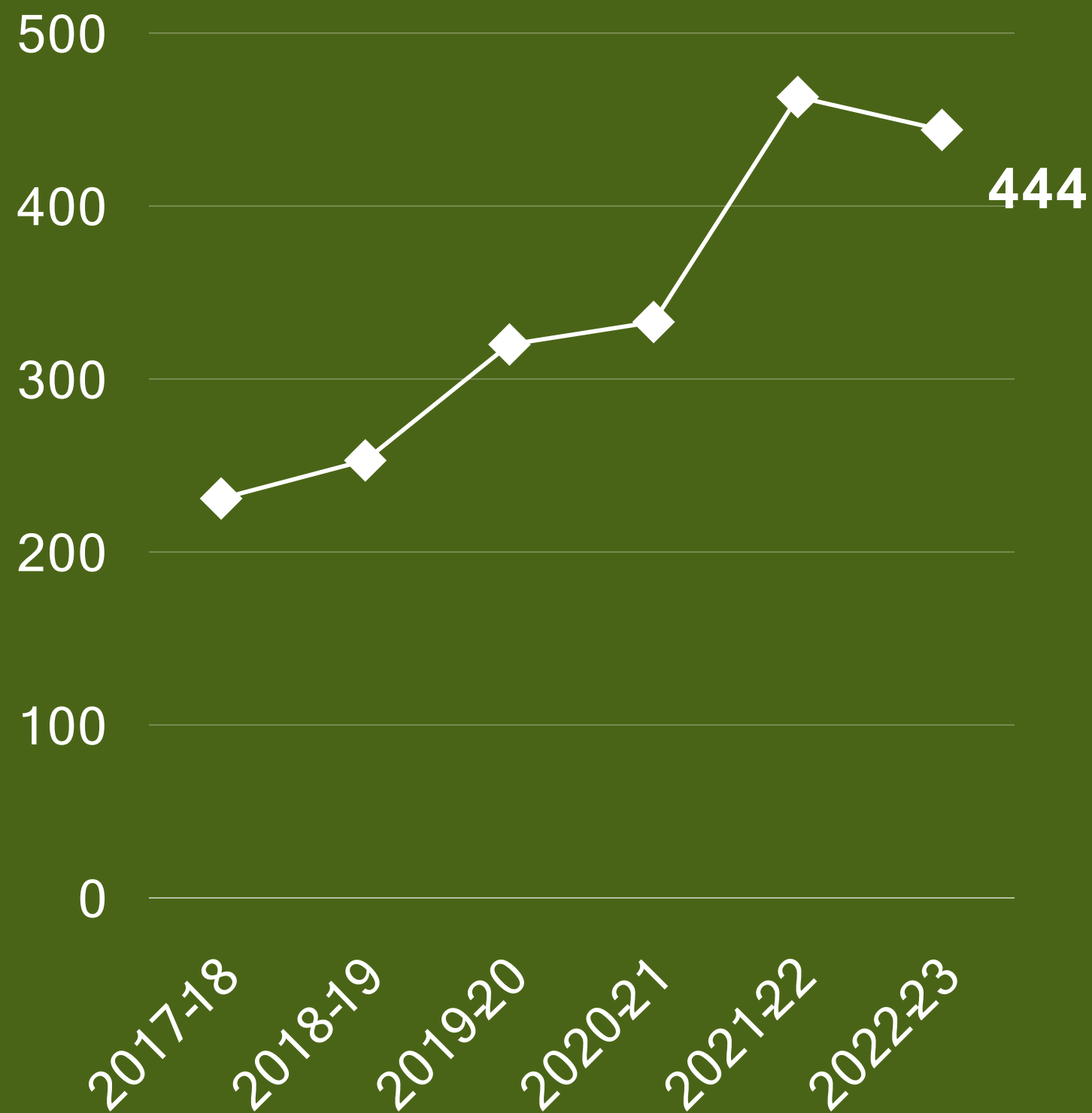


Full-Time Offers and Average CTC

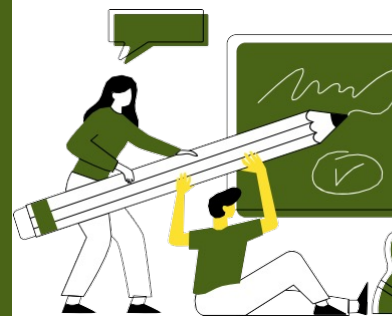
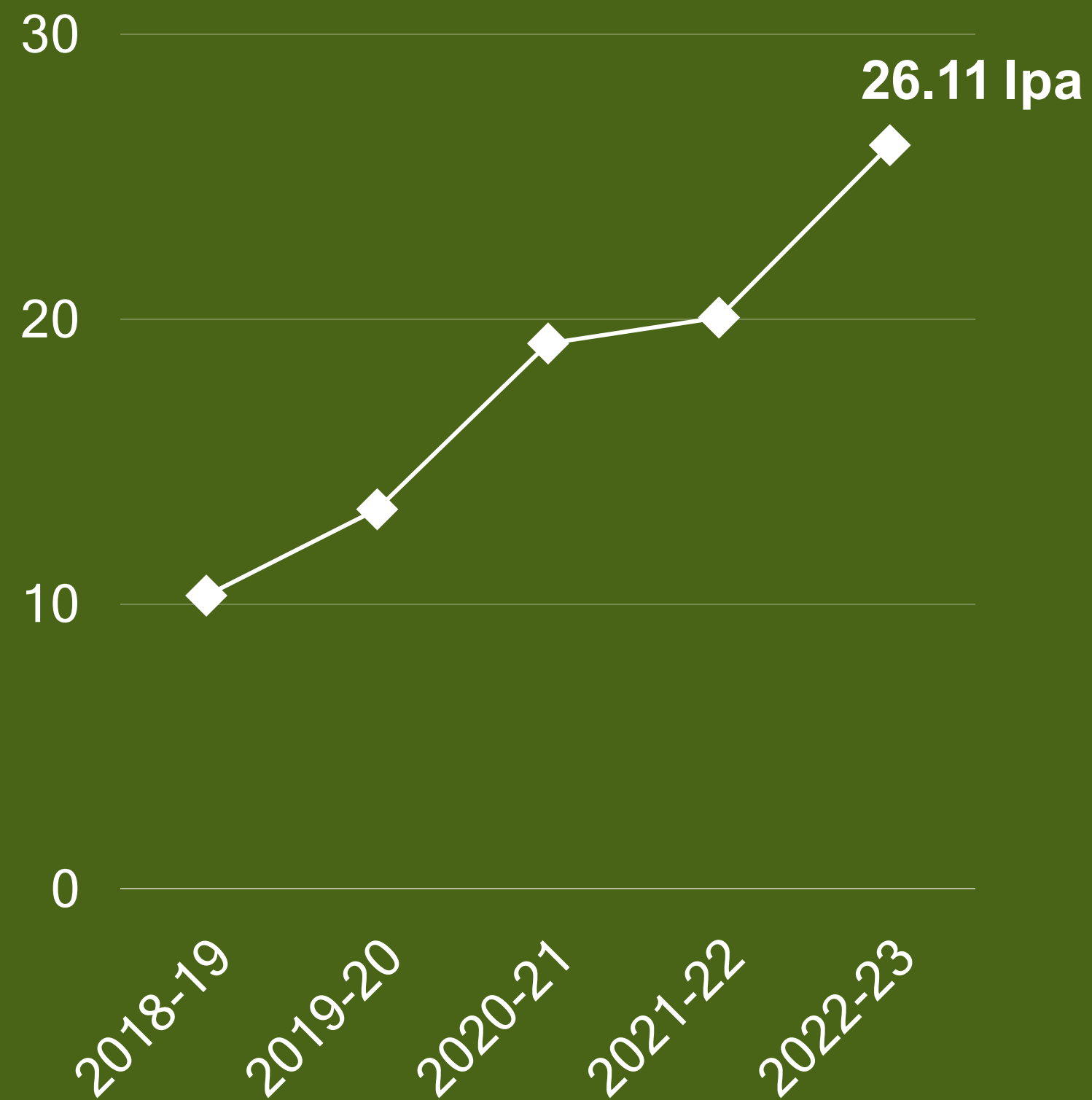

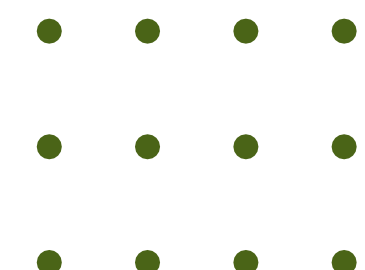

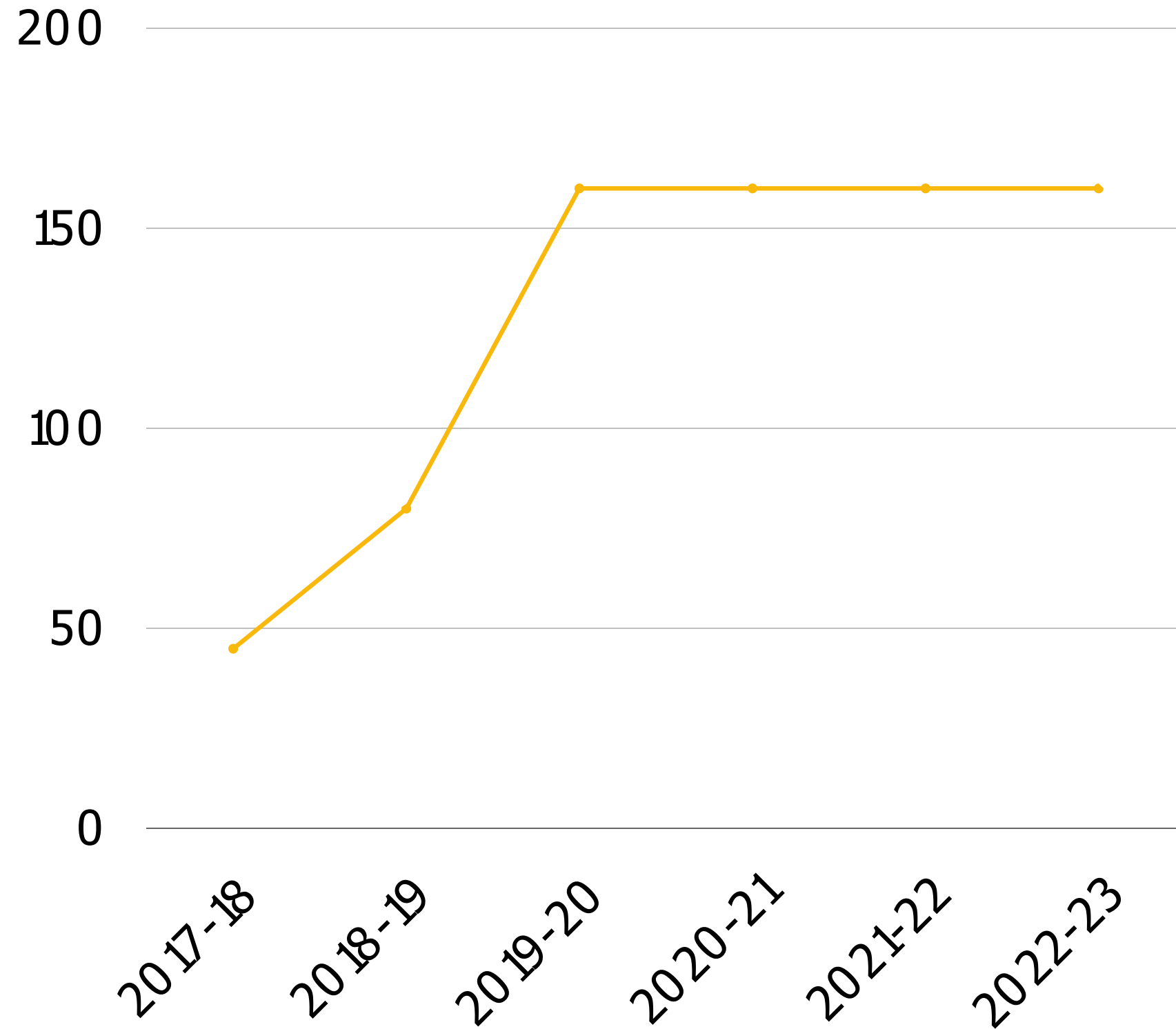
- UG students are not proceeding for 6 months internship due to offline classes.
- PG students proceeded for 1year internships due to revised curriculum.



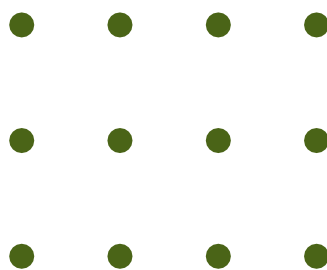


Highest Internship Stipend Offered

- Recently, **Uber has also started offering pre-placement offers to the incoming interns.**

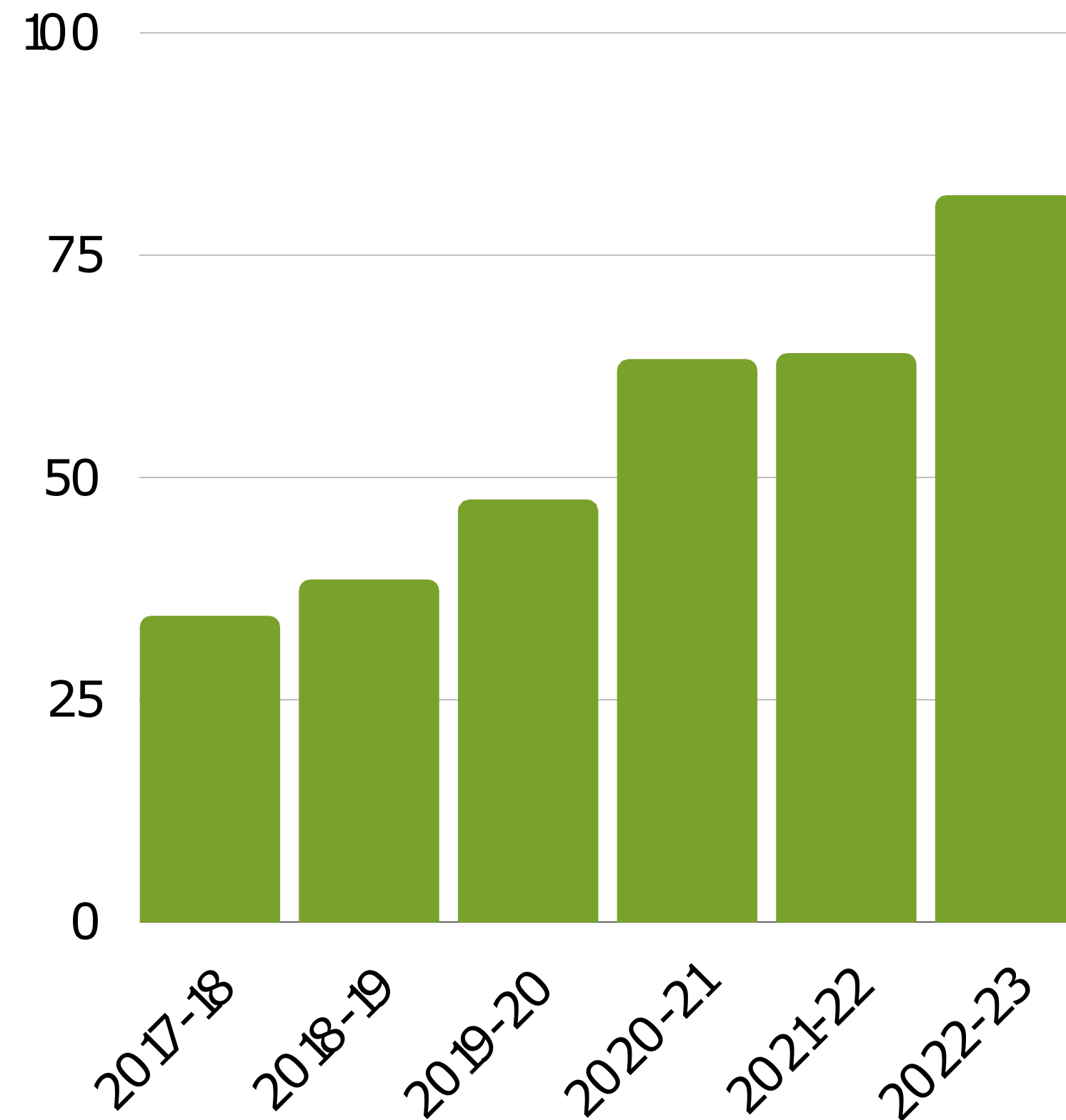
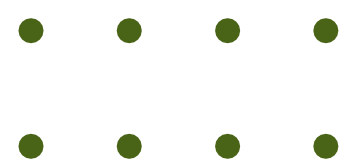




Average Summer Internship Stipend offered

- Students will be proceeding for their internships in June 2023.

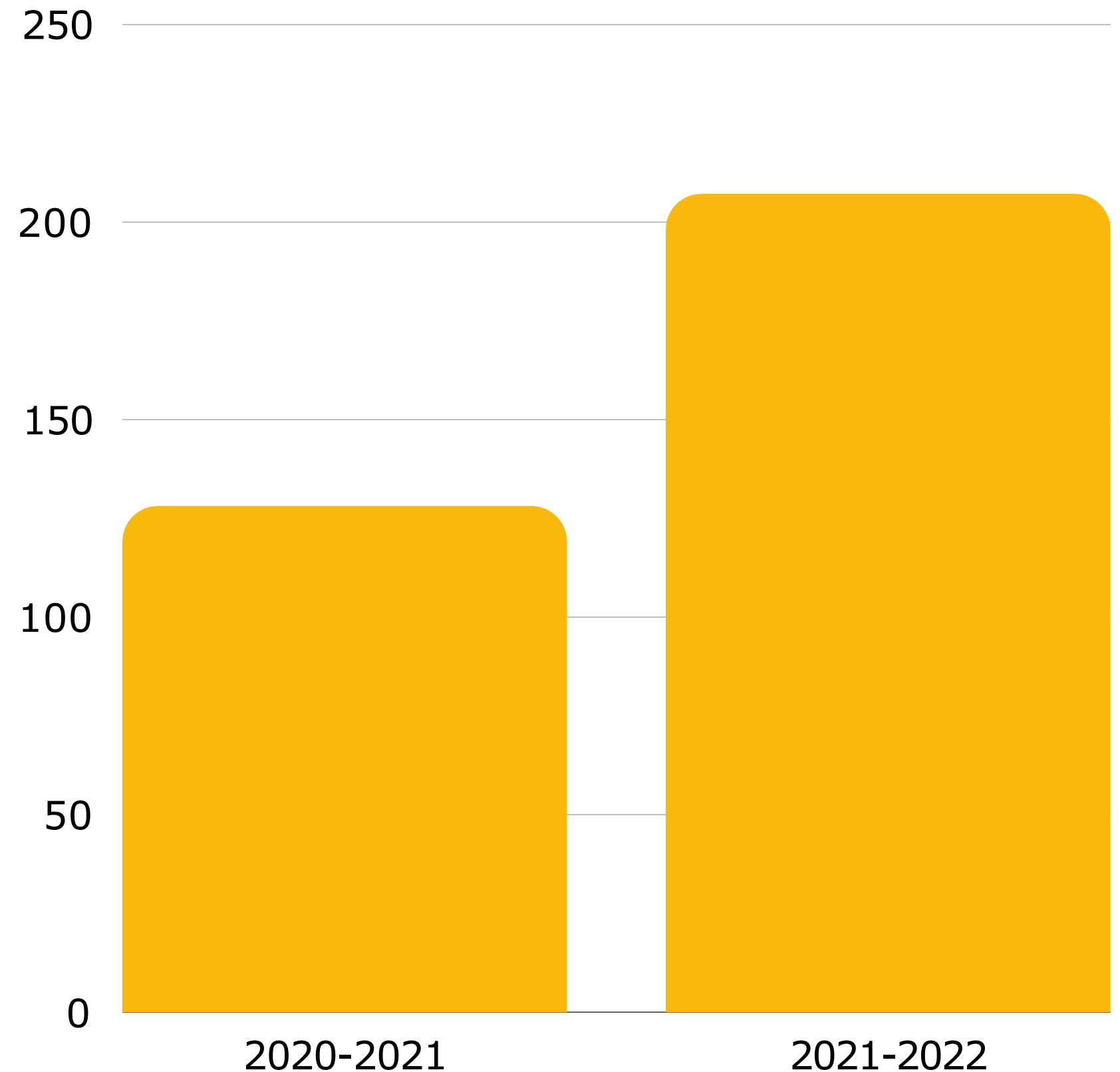




Pre-Placement Offers

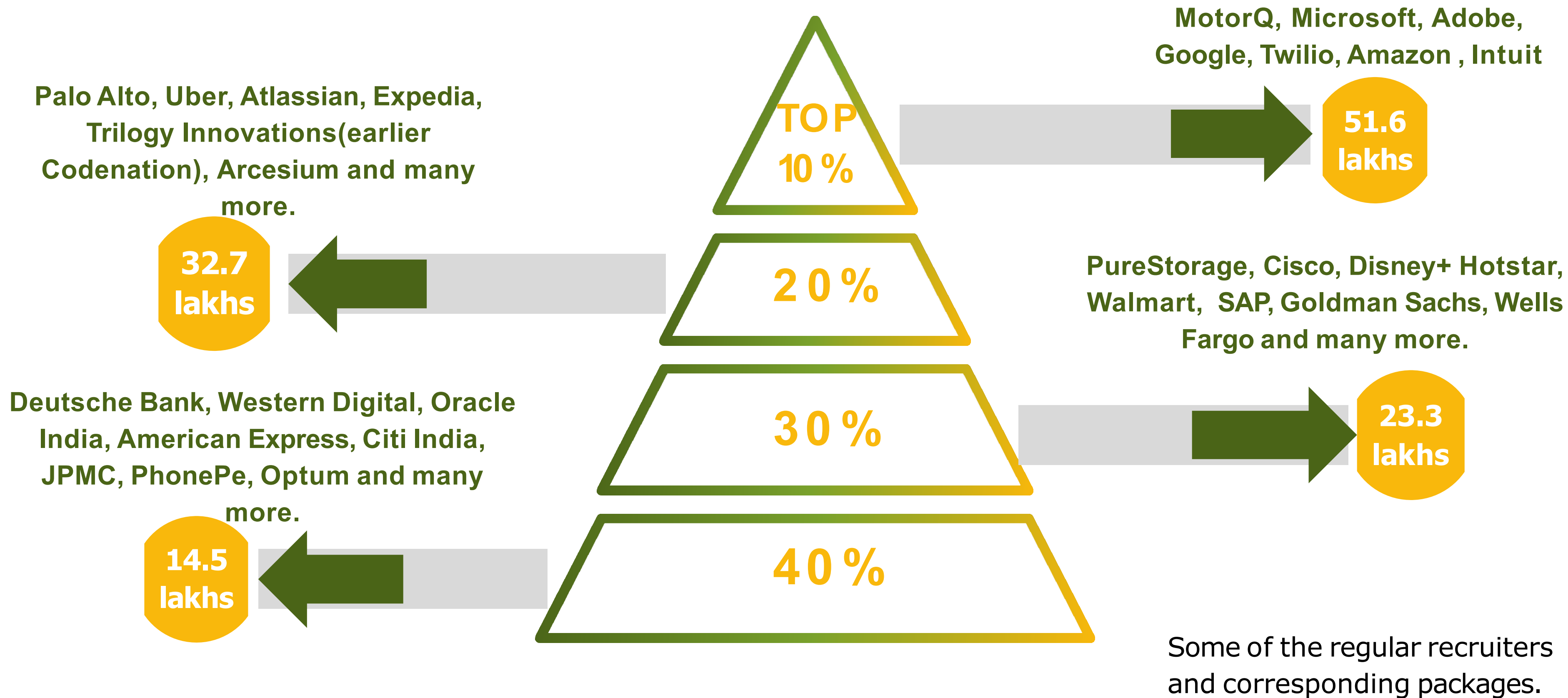


- Total number of pre-placement offers for batch **2020-2021 =128**

Average CTC (LPA) Pyramid

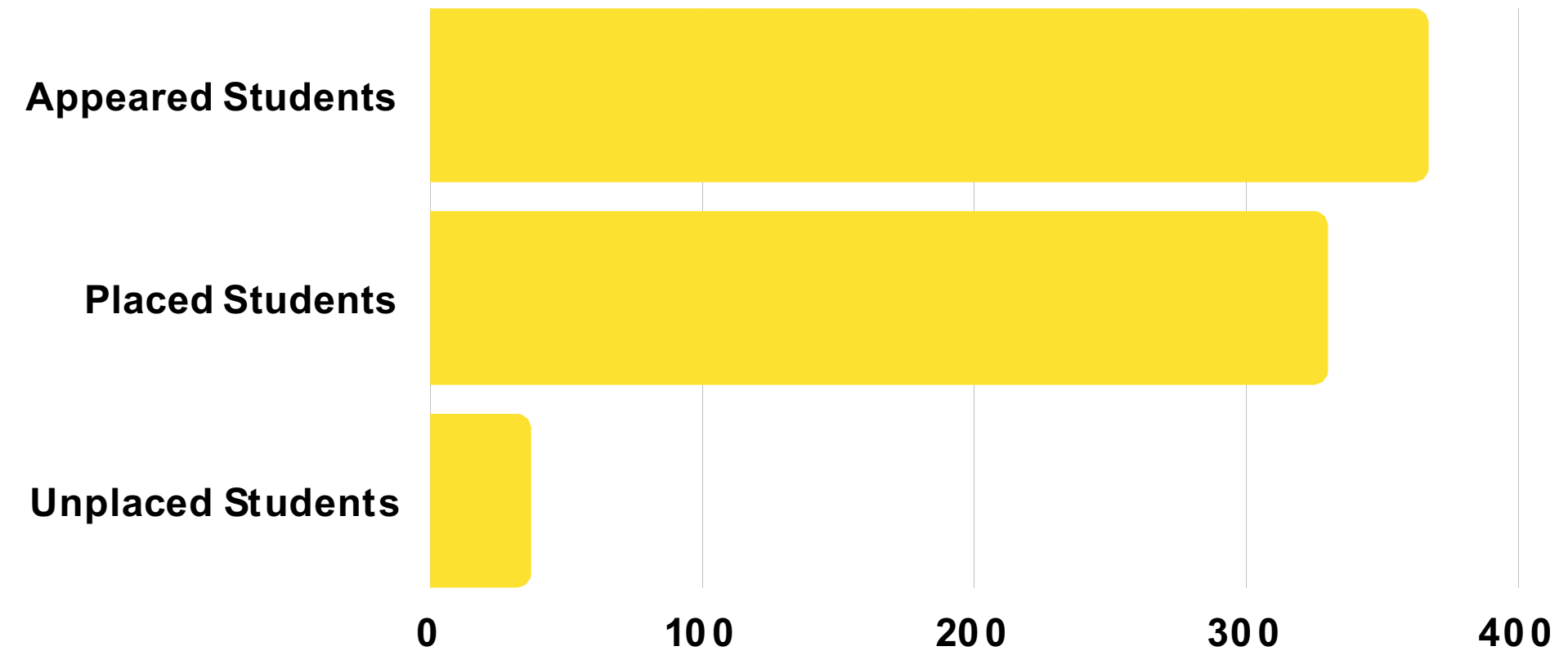




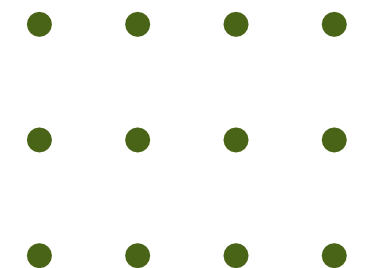

Success Stories



Google visited the campus for Software, Application and Silicon engineers' role and offered 3 FTE and 12 summer internship offers. 11 students got pre-placement offers whereas multiple students bagged off campus offers as well.

For second years students, 11 out of 12 students got PPI, that is, internship for third year.



Microsoft visited the campus this year for Software Engineer role and 2 FTE offers were rolled out by them. Along with that 35 out of 53 students bagged PPO for FTE roles after their summer internship at Microsoft.

96 summer internships were offered to the students of our university via Microsoft Engage program.



A lot of companies like Cisco, Amazon, Oyo, Western Digital, American Express, JP Morgan Chase, Tower Research etc. voluntarily gave 6-months internships to the students.

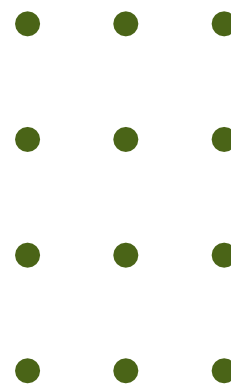

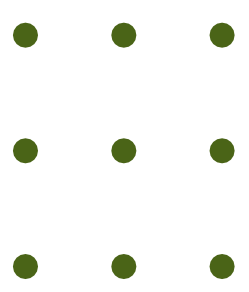

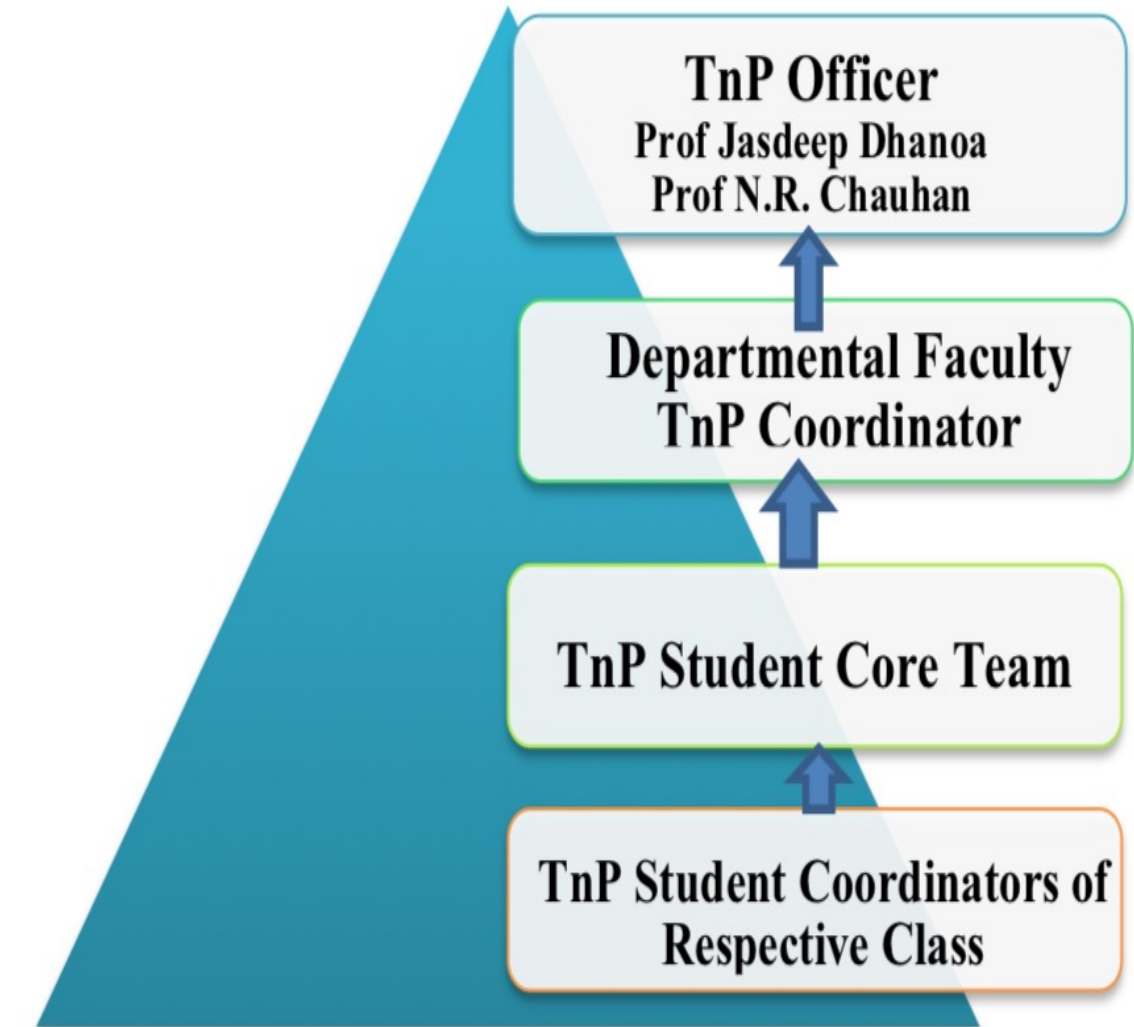
