(4) The Academic Council shall - (a) exercise general supervision over the academic policies of the University and to give directions regarding methods of instruction, evaluation or research or improvement in academic standards; (b) consider maters of general academic interest either on its own initiative or on a reference from		
		the Planning Board or a Department / School of studies or the Board of Management and to take appropriate action thereon; and (c) frame such regulations as are consistent with the Statutes and the Ordinances regarding the academic functioning of the University, including discipline, admissions, award of fellowships and studentships, fees and other academic requirements.
