Eligibility Criteria:-

1. The students should have been enrolled for under graduate programme in any of the Delhi state public Universities or college/ Institutes affiliated to Delhi state public Universities.

2. The student should fulfill the income/economic and academic performance criteria as specified for each category mentioned below:-

Eligibility (Gross Annual Family Income of student from all source	percentage (Marks in all Subjects)	Percentage of Financial Assistance
<u>Category 1</u> Beneficiary under National Food Security scheme & possess the Card issued under the scheme	60%	100%
Category 2 Not covered under category 1 but whose family income is up to 2.5 lac per annum	60%	50%
<u>Category 3</u> Family income above Rs. 2.5 lac per annum but not exceeding Rs. 6 Lac per annum	60%	25%

A relaxation of 5% in qualifying aggregate percentage of marks will be allowed to SC/ST category students.

Additional Documents for Students Requesting Financial Assistance of 25%:- Copy of the full Income Tax Return (including the acknowledgment page) for both parents filed with Income Tax Department for the previous financial year. In the case of a non-working parent, an affidavit affirming non-employment certified by the office of SDM / competent authority and family income certificate issued by the SDM / competent authority.
